This is an application for expeditious hearing of the N.D.P.S. Case No. 83 of 2018, pending before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, 1st Court (Special Court, N.D.P.S. Act) at Krishnagar, Nadia.

Mr. Pratick Bose, learned advocate, is requested to appear in this matter. Let his appointment be regularized.

It has been submitted by the learned advocate for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody for more than three years.
