Heard the learned advocates appearing for the respective parties.

Having considered the materials in the case diary and bearing in mind the nature of allegations in the light of the submission that the victim was major at the time of cohabitation and was aware of the consequences thereof, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Petitioner shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application being CRM 6371 of 2021 is disposed of.
