This is an application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India wherein the writ petitioner is aggrieved by non-issuance of offer letter to the petitioner inspite of the application for permit having been allowed by the board resolution dated February 27, 2020.

I have heard counsel appearing for the parties and perused the materials on record. In light of the submissions made, I direct the authority concerned of the State Transport Authority, West Bengal to issue offer letter to the petitioner within a period of three weeks from date.

With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. There will be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavit-in-opposition is called for, the allegations made in the writ petition are deemed not to have been admitted.
