CRM 6521 of 2021

In re : An Application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on 21.09.2021 in connection with Pursurah Police Station Case No. 112 of 2021 dated 13.08.2021 under Sections 498(A)/406/307/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the husband was granted bail. He submits that, since the police submitted charge-sheet custodial interrogation of the petitioners are not required.

State is represented.

Considering that the husband was granted bail by the jurisdictional court and considering the fact that the police submitted charge-sheet, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date and with a further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional court on every date fixed for hearing.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed.

CRM 6521 of 2021 is disposed of.
