Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for about 120 days and the police submitted charge sheet and, therefore, further detention of the petitioner is not required. He submits that there is a counter case where the mother of the petitioner suffered injury. He submits that the petitioner is an employee of a Bank.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the contents in the case diary, particularly to the statements recorded under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code of the eye-witnesses.

Considering the statements recorded under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code of the eye-witnesses and considering the involvement of the petitioner in the incident, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

CRM 6680 of 2021 is **dismissed**.
