(Through Video Conference)**

The petitioner seeks expeditious disposal of N.D.P.S. Case No. 124/2019 under Section 21 (c) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, pending before the learned Special Court under N.D.P.S. Act cum A.D.J., 2nd Court, Berhampore, Murshidabad.

It has been submitted by the learned advocate for the petitioner that, the dates for evidence have been fixed by the learned Judge in the Court below in different occasions, however, recording of the evidence has not yet commenced.

In this pandemic situation, it is not expected that the learned Judge in the Court below shall proceed with the trial at a normal pace.
