CRM 6699 of 2021

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Deganga** Police Station Case No. **200 of 2021** dated **08.04.2021** under **Sections 498A/304B/302** of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3/ 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act which ended up in charge sheet no. 349 of 2021 dated 19.06.2021 under Sections 498A/304B/406 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3/ 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Petitioner seeks bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for about 171 days. Since police submitted charge sheet, further detention of the petitioner is not required.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the contents in the case diary.

Considering the materials in the case diary and considering the period of detention and the fact that police submitted charge sheet, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Chief

Judicial Magistrate, North 24-Parganas, Barasat, subject to condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event, the petitioner fails to appear before the trial court without any justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel the bail of the petitioner in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for bail is **allowed**.

CRM 6699 of 2021 is **disposed of**.
