The learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition has been preferred challenging the selection process pertaining to the 1<sup>st</sup> State Level Selection Test, 2016 for recruitment to the post of assistant teachers in Upper Primary Schools in the State of West Bengal.

By a judgment delivered on 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 in similar matters, a coordinate Bench of this Court has set aside and cancelled the selection process for appointment of candidates to the post of assistant teachers of Upper Primary Schools in the State of West Bengal pursuant to the notification published for the said posts on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2016.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of.

Since no affidavit-in-opposition is called for, allegations made in the writ petition are deemed not to have been admitted.
