Bail is prayed for on the ground that the petitioner is in custody for 52 days and that the co-accused have already been granted bail. It appears from the records that the petitioner has been charged with forging the signature of the Pradhan of the Gram Panchayat for the purpose of availing the Dware Sarkar benefit of the Government of West Bengal.

Counsel for the State submits that the investigation is still on.

In that view of the matter, the application for bail of the petitioner stands **rejected** at this stage.

It is, however, ordered that the investigation be completed as expeditiously as possibly, preferably within a period of four months from the date of communication of a copy of this order and the final report may be submitted to the Jurisdictional Magistrate.

CRM 6936 of 2021 is, accordingly, **disposed of**.
