Petitioner is in custody for 97 days. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he has been falsely implicated in the instant case. Investigation is complete.

Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for bail

Learned lawyer for the de facto complainant submits that the petitioner is the habitual offender and another case based on similar allegations has been registered against the petitioner.

We have considered the materials on record. Statements of witnesses show that the petitioner received money on the false promise of giving employment. Petitioner has criminal antecedent. Hence, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail is rejected.
