This is an application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India wherein the writ petitioner is aggrieved by the inaction on the part of the respondent authorities in considering her application for general transfer on special ground under Rule 4(1)(c) of the West Bengal School Service Commission (General Transfer, Transfer on Special Grounds and Reallocation) Rules, 2015.

I have heard counsel appearing on behalf of the parties and perused the materials placed on record.

Accordingly, the Commissioner of School Education being the respondent no.2 herein is directed to pass a reasoned order within a period of eight weeks from date with regard to the application made by the petitioner.

I make it clear that I have not gone into the merits of the case.
