Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

We have considered the statements of the eye witnesses disclosing that the petitioner assaulted the victim on the head resulting in his death.

In view of the aforesaid facts and the prima facie involvement of the petitioner in the alleged crime as the principal accused and since he does not stand on the same footing with co-accused, who was enlarged on bail, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail is rejected.

However, trial court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same at an early date preferably within one year from the next date fixed for recording of evidence without granting adjournment to either of the parties.
