The petitioners by filing the present application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India have prayed for expeditious disposal of the Title Suit No. 1190 of 2018, pending before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 5th Court, Howrah.

The learned advocate for the petitioners submits that the learned Court below has been granting unnecessary adjournments and due to which, there is a delay in disposal of the case and such delay is causing hardship to the petitioners.

Having regard to the nature of relief claimed by the petitioner, being a prayer for expeditious disposal of the title suit, I do not find any need to serve notice of the present application on the opposite parties and it is not likely to cause any prejudice to the interest of the opposite parties. Therefore, service of notice upon the opposite parties is dispensed with.

The learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 5th Court, Howrah, is requested to dispose of the Title Suit No. 1190 of 2018, as expeditiously as possible and in any event, within a period of one year from the date of

communication of this order but giving regard to the diary maintained by him/her.

Accordingly, the revisional application **being C.O. 1895 of 2021** is disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.
