The petitioner complains that the private respondent is interfering with the cultivation of land belonging to him.

It is submitted that a complaint has been lodged with the Balagarh Police Station HRPD. The police did not take any steps.

Counsel for the State produces instructions of the Officer-in-Charge, Balagarh P.S. dated November 22, 2021 addressed to the Government Pleader. The same is taken on record. It appears that on receipt of complaint from the petitioner a proceeding under Section 107 has been drawn up.

In that view of the matter, reserving rights of the parties to approach a civil court for settlement of their disputes, the officer-in-charge Balagarh Police Station is hereby directed to ensure that there is no breach of peace in

the area and should continue to maintain a regular vigil thereat.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of.
