Petitioner seeks parity with other co-accused who was granted anticipatory bail on November 11, 2021 in CRM 7243 of 2021.

Heard the learned Advocate for the State.

Considering the materials in the case diary and the order dated November 11, 2021, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and with a further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the investigating officer once in a month and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed.

CRM 7254 of 2021 is disposed of.
