Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were falsely implicated. The police complaint is a result of village rivalry. He submits that since the police filed charge-sheet custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the statements recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of the victim and the medical report.

Considering the materials in the case diary and considering the statement recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and the medical report of the victim, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.

CRM 7415 of 2021 is, accordingly, dismissed.
