In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on 16.11.2021 in connection with **Pandabeswar** P.S. Case No. **54 of 2021** dated **09/04/2021** under Sections **498A/306/406/120B** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, read with Sections **3/4** of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Having heard the learned Advocates appearing for the petitioner and the State and having considered the materials in the case diary and having considered the fact that the police submitted charge sheet, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that she shall

appear before the jurisdictional Court on the dates fixed for trial and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail being C.R.M. 7496 of 2021 is, thus, disposed of.
