The petitioner prays for a direction upon the 2nd respondent to dispose of the application filed by the petitioner before the State authority for computation of gratuity following his superannuation on *July 1, 2019*. The said application is pending since *16th December, 2019*.

Having considered the submissions made on behalf of the parties and material on record, I dispose of the writ petition with a direction upon the 2nd respondent to consider and dispose of the application filed by the petitioner dated *16th December, 2019* within a period of two months from the date of communication of this order after giving a reasonable opportunity of hearing to the

affected parties including the petitioner, in accordance with law.

W.P.A. 18395 of 2021 is thus disposed of.

I have not gone into the merits of the case and the petitioner is at liberty to take all the points mentioned before this Court, before the Authority.

There shall be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavit has been invited, allegations contained in the writ petition shall be deemed not to have been admitted.
