We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner along with other accused persons induced unemployed youths to part with money on the false promise of giving employment. Petitioner had sent fake interview letters through his E-mail account to some of the victims. Prayer for bail of the co-accused persons was rejected by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM No. 7185 of 2015.

In view of the aforesaid fact and considering the prima facie involvement of the petitioner in the alleged crime and gravity of the offence, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

The application for bail is, thus, rejected.
