In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on 22.11.2021 in connection with **Raiganj** P.S. Case No. **454 of 2021** dated **08/06/2021** under Sections **341/323/325/307/379/34** of the Indian Penal Code corresponding to G.R. No.1198 of 2021.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that out of seven accused six were enlarged on bail. He submits that the police submitted charge sheet and, therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the contents in the case diary.

Considering the fact that the police submitted charge sheet and considering the fact that out of seven accused six were enlarged on bail, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the

petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional Court on the dates fixed for trial and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail being C.R.M. 7679 of 2021 is, thus, disposed of.
