Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was falsely implicated. There are disputes between the private parties. Police complaint is a result of such disputes.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the injury report.

Considering the materials in the case diary and considering the gravity of the offences and the injuries suffered by the victim, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
