Learned Counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the trial is at its fag end.

We have considered the materials on record. There are prima facie materials connecting the petitioner with the alleged crime. Trial is at its fag end. Accordingly, we are not inclined in granting bail to the petitioner

The application for bail is, thus, rejected.

However, we request the trial court to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six months from the next date fixed for recording of evidence

without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.
