Leave is granted to correct the cause title.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there was dispute amongst the parties over cutting of a tree.

Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

We have considered the materials on record. Whether injuries are grievous or not requires to be assessed in the light of the attending facts and circumstances during trial.

Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Petitioner shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application being CRM 8059 of 2021 is disposed of.
