It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they are not the principal accused.

Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

We have considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioners in the alleged crime, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Petitioners shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application being CRM 8073 of 2021 is disposed of.
