The petitioner is represented by Mr. Sounak Ghosh, learned advocate and he specifically moves the revisional application and prays for expeditious disposal of Application under Order 39 Rule 4 Civil Procedure Code filed by it on 12th March, 2019 in Misc. Appeal No. 234 of 2018 pending before the Additional District Judge, 10th Court at Alipore, South 24 Parganas.
