It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners there is a dispute amongst the family members and they have been falsely implicated in the instant case.

Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

We have considered the materials on record. No one was injured in the course of the incident. In view of the aforesaid facts, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is thus allowed.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
