Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Considering the fact that the complaint was lodged after a period of two and half months of the incident and considering the fact that the petitioners are ladies and considering the fact that the principal accused is in custody and considering the fact that the police submitted charge sheet, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional Court on the dates fixed for trial and pray for regular bail within four weeks

from date.

The application for anticipatory bail being C.R.M. 8791 of 2021 is, thus, disposed of.
