The revisional application was preferred challenging the proceeding arising out of Arambag Police Station Case No. 55 of 2006 dated 03.04.2006. Records reflect that on completion of investigation charge-sheet was filed by the Investigating Officer against the present petitioner. The petitioner in this revisional application has relied upon documents which include orders passed by the High Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the F.I.R. and the charge-sheet.

Md. Anwar Hossain, learned advocate appearing for the State has submitted a report of the Inspector-in-Charge, Arambag Police Station. Report reflects that the evidence of the case has already started and very recently the date was fixed by the Court on 20.04.2022.

Taking into account the stage of the case which has progressed I am of the view that the trial should be taken to its logical conclusion.

The application being CRR 2774 of 2012 is dismissed.

Pending application, if any, is consequently disposed of.

Interim order, if any, is hereby vacated.
