Since it appears from the submissions of learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that prayer in the present writ petition which is for suspension of the petitioner's services by a memo dated 1st August, 2017 is required to be revisited by reason of a subsequent order of suspension dated 13th August, 2019, the petitioner is directed to file a fresh writ petition challenging the subsequent order of suspension. Some of the documents leading to the second order dated 13th August, 2019 are to be found in the supplementary affidavit filed by the petitioner but do not enclose in the final order of suspension.

WPA 25408 of 2017 is accordingly dismissed as having become infructuous.

The petitioner is given liberty to file a fresh writ petition on a fresh cause of action subject to the alternative remedy available to the writ petitioner.
