The order proposed to be passed in the present application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India would not cause any prejudice to the opposite party, as such service of notice of the present application upon the opposite party is dispensed with.

The petitioner is the plaintiff of Ejectment Suit No. 539 of 2013, which is pending before the 3rd Bench of learned Chief Judge, Presidency Small Causes Court at Calcutta. The petitioner by the present revisional application is seeking a direction upon the learned trial Judge for expeditious disposal of the said suit.

The Courts are resuming normal functioning during this Covid-19 pandemic period at this stage this Court is not inclined to pass any direction for disposal of any *lis* within a specific period, but considering that the suit has attained the stage of peremptory hearing and the witness action of the plaintiff is going on, it is expected and desired that the

learned trial Judge shall make all endeavour to dispose of the said suit expeditiously and in doing so shall not grant any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.

C.O. 1566 of 2020 is disposed of with the above terms.
