When the writ petition is taken up for hearing Mr. Bhattacharya, learned advocate representing the petitioner submits that for proper adjudication of this matter relating to appointment of the writ petitioner on compassionate ground upon setting aside the Memo date 24th February, 2020 passed by the District Inspector of Schools (S.E.), South 24 Parganas challenged needs to be thrown to G.O.
