Mr. Ekramul Bari, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners fairly submits that this writ petition is incomplete, and accordingly, seeks liberty to approach before the Gorkhaland Territorial Administration with the same reliefs sought in this writ petition.

In the light of the above submission, this writ petition is disposed of with liberty given to the petitioners to approach the Gorkhaland Territorial Administration by filing a representation with the grievances mentioned in this writ petition.

In the event, the representation is made by the petitioners within a week from date, the Gorkhaland Territorial Administration is directed to dispose of the same by passing a reasoned order within a period of six weeks from date.

The reasoned order should be communicated to petitioners within a week from the date of passing such reasoned order.

disposed of.

Since, no affidavit-in-opposition has been called for, the allegations made in the writ petition are deemed to have not been admitted by the respondents.

There will be no order as to costs.
