The writ petitioner complains that matrimonial dispute has arisen and MAT Suit No. 1765 of 2019 is pending before the learned District Judge, Barasat. The petitioner has complained to the Nagrakata Police Station at Jalpaiguri as regards cruelty, criminal breach of trust and attempt to murder against her husband and in-laws.

The facts as regards where the alleged torture occurred are rather sketchy and not clear before this court.
