In view of the submissions made on behalf of the Counsel for the respective parties that the petitioners stand on the same footing as that of Dilip Sarkar who was granted anticipatory bail by a coordinate Bench on 20th July, 2021, we allow this application for anticipatory bail on the same terms and conditions.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners, namely, **Madhu Sarkar and Robi Sarkar @ Rabi Sarkar @ Noni Sarkar**, shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each , with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer of the concerned police station and on condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and on further condition that the petitioners shall meet the Investigation Officer once in a week.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed and CRM 1163 of 2021 is accordingly, disposed of.
