The Court : This contempt application arises out of alleged violation of orders dated 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2003 passed in W. P. No. 3685 of 1993 and 24<sup>th</sup> December, 2003 passed in G. A. 4242 of 2003 filed in WP No.3685 of 1993. The matter appeared in the list on 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2021, when no one appeared on behalf of any of the parties even at the second call. The matter is appearing in the day's list marked as 'Last Chance' with a note that appropriate orders will be passed if no one appears when the matter is taken up.
