O R D E R

1. The revenue has filed the present appeal against the order dated 18th August, 2017 passed by the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal "A" Bench, Kolkata, in I.T.A. No. 1379/Kol/2009 for the assessment year 2006-2007.
2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the amount of income tax involved in the present appeal is less than ₹ one crore.
