The Court : This contempt application arises out of alleged violation of orders dated 6th March, 1998 and 27th November, 1998 passed in W. P. No. 2126 of 1997 and C.C.No. 205 of 1998 respectively. The matter appeared in the list on 20th September, 2021, when no one appeared on behalf of any of the parties even at the second call. The matter is appearing in the day's list marked as 'Last Chance' with a note that appropriate orders will be passed if no one appears when the matter is taken up.

No one has applied for joining in the virtual mode. None of the parties are represented when the matter is called on. It appears that the parties are not interested in proceeding with the matter.
