The Court: This contempt application arises out of alleged violation of an order dated 30th July, 1998 passed in W.P. No. 1944 of 1993 and CC No. 23 of 1999 dated 29.01.1999 and 09.02.1999. The matter appeared in the list on 12th August, 2021, when no one appeared on behalf of any of the parties even at the second call. The matter is appearing in the day's list marked as 'Last Chance' with a note that appropriate orders will be passed if no one appears when the matter is taken up.

No one has applied for joining in the virtual mode. None of the parties are represented when the matter is called on. It appears that the parties are not interested in proceeding with the matter.
