O R D E R

1. The revenue has filed the present appeal against the order dated February 24, 2016 passed by the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal "A" Bench, Kolkata in I.T.A. Nos. 639, 640, 641, 642, 643 and 644/Kol/2009 for the assessment years 2000-01, 2001-02, 2002-03, 2003-04, 2004-05 and 2005-06 respectively.

1. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the amount of income tax involved in the present appeal is less than ₹ 1 crore. The same being below the minimum limit prescribed for filing or pursuing of appeals in the High Court vide Circular No.17/2019 F.No.279/Misc.142/2007-ITJ(Pt.) issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department

of Revenue, Central Board of Direct Taxes, Judicial Section dated August 8, 2019, the appellant may be permitted to withdraw the present appeal.

2. The present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn, however, keeping open the questions of law raised therein.
