1. The defaults pointed out by the Registry of this Court in the instant case stand ignored as of now.
2. With the consent of learned Counsels appearing for their respective parties, heard the matter finally at admission stage itself.
3. The limited grievance of Petitioners in the present Writ Petition is that they are entitled for the benefit of Kramonnati on completing 10 years of service which they have completed, but they have not been given the same till date.
4. Given the limited grievance raised, let Petitioners make a detailed representation in this regard to Respondents No. 2 & 4 who in turn shall scrutinize the same and pass a suitable order in accordance with the rules governing the field of Kramonnati. It is expected that an appropriate order shall be passed within a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of representation of Petitioners.

5. With the aforesaid observations, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
