Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that though the petitioner is entitled for medical reimbursement from May, 2007 to October, 2011 amounting to Rs. 5,22,562/-, but that has not been considered and paid to him by respondents No. 2 to 4 for which he has already made representations (Annexure P/10) but they have not been considered till date, as such, necessary direction be issued to respondents No. 2 to 4.
2. Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 to 4 would submit that petitioner's representations will be considered expeditiously.
3. I have heard learned counsel for the parties at length.
4. Be that as it may, respondents No. 2 to 4 are directed to consider petitioner's representations qua reimbursement of medical bills from May, 2007 to October, 2011 within 45 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order strictly in accordance with the applicable Rules by passing a reasoned and speaking order. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.

5. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of.
