the authorities concerned i.e. respondents No.1 & 3 may consider and take an appropriate decision at the earliest.

Considering the limited grievance that the petitioner has, the writ petition at this juncture stands disposed of directing the respondents to immediately consider and decide the representation of the petitioner in accordance with rules and regulations governing the field at the earliest preferably within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
