counsel Shri Akhtar Hussain through video conferencing, he is identified by his counsel through aadhar card. Injured Santosh Patel stated that he has no objection to grant bail to the applicant by this Court.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.
7. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the fact that injured Santosh Patel sustained injuries on different parts of his body which were simple in nature, the detention period of the applicant who is 23 years old, the fact that the applicant has no criminal antecedents, there is no apprehension of the applicant tampering with the evidence or absconding as admitted by both the counsel, and that due to Covid-19 pandemic, conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the bail application is allowed.
8. It is directed that in the event of applicant executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court, he shall be released on bail, on following conditions :-
 - i. he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such fact to the Court.
 - ii. he shall not act in any manner which will be prejudicial to fair and expeditious trial, and
 - iii. he shall appear before the trial Court on each and every date given to him by the said Court till disposal of the trial.
 - iv. he shall strictly follow the COVID-19 protocol issued by the Central Government / State Government / Local Authority.
 - v. he shall not involve himself in any offence of similar nature in future.
9. Let a copy of this order be forwarded to the concerned Police Station forthwith who shall inform the trial Court in the event of applicant involving himself in similar nature of offence
