This petition has been brought under Article 227 of the Constitution of India being aggrieved by the order dated 25.05.2021, by which the application filed by the petitioner, praying for passing orders to maintain status-quo over the disputed property was rejected by the learned District Judge, Bastar at Jagdalpur.
2. After hearing the submission, this petition is disposed off at motion stage. The petitioner has already filed a Miscellaneous Appeal No.1/2021, before the Court of District Judge, Bastar at Jagdalpur,

which is pending for final hearing.
