Hon'ble Shri Justice Narendra Kumar Vyas**Order on Board****15-07-2021**

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has filed a complaint against respondent No.1 for offence punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 read with Section 420 of IPC before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Kharsiya, District Raigarh in the year 2018 which was registered as Case No. 143 of 2018 but the same has not been till today.
2. This court cannot lose sight of the fact that for the last two years India as well as the whole world are aversely affected by the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic which has hampered not only

judicial proceedings but also the normal life of citizens. Now, the Full Court vide its order dated 13-7-2021 has directed the subordinate court for physical hearing from Monday i.e., 19-7-2021.

3. In view of such subsequent development, it is directed that learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Kharsiya shall make endeavor to conclude the trial within outer limit of one year from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
4. With the aforesaid observation, the instant petition is disposed of.
