Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of directing the petitioner to approach the respondents No.2 to 5 by way of a fresh representation in addition to whatever representation that he has made in the past and the respondents no. 2 to 5 in turn shall scrutinize the same in accordance with the provision of law governing the field and an appropriate decision shall be taken at the earliest preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
4. Writ Petition accordingly stands disposed of with the aforesaid direction/observation.
