1. The claim of the petitioner in the present writ petition is for an appropriate direction to the respondents to take an early decision for acting upon the order Annexure P/2 dated 04.12.2020, whereby the petitioner has been allotted the quarter No. DNK-35 located at Mana Camp Raipur.
