1. Challenge in the present writ petition is to the impugned order Annexure P/1 dated 17.08.2021. Vide the said order the services of the petitioner has been placed under suspension on the alleged ground of misconduct.
2. Prima-facie, this Court is of the opinion that the order under challenge is an appealable under Rule 23 of the **Chhattisgarh Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1966**.
3. Since the petitioner has a statutory alternative remedy available, it would not be appropriate for the High Court at this juncture to

entertain the writ petition. Reserving the right of the petitioner to prefer a departmental appeal under Rule 23, the present writ petition at this juncture stands disposed of. Subject to the petitioner preferring an appeal, the Appellate Authority is expected to take a decision on its own merits within the period of time as stipulated in the statutes.

4. With the aforesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
