This is the *first* bail application filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 on behalf of the applicant for grant of regular bail to him as he is in custody in connection with Crime No. 240/2021 registered at Police Station Baramkela, District Raigarh (C.G.) for the offence punishable under Section 20(B) of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substance Act.
2. It is submitted that the applicant is innocent who has been falsely implicated in this case. The applicant is in jail since 29/07/2021. Charge-sheet has been filed, therefore, prayer is made to release the applicant on bail.

3. Per contra, learned State counsel opposes the bail application.
4. I have heard the learned counsel for both the parties and perused the case diary.
5. As per prosecution case, in total 4kg of ganja narcotic substance was seized from the possession of this applicant and the same was being transported by him on a motorcycle. Hence, this bail application.
6. Considered on the submissions. The applicant does not have any criminal antecedent and there is likelihood of delay in conclusion of trial and investigation, I feel inclined to allow this bail application and release the applicant on bail.
7. Accordingly, the bail application filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is allowed. It is directed that the applicant shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court, for his appearance as and when directed.
