1. The petition is taken up at the request of the counsel for the petitioner who wants the disposal of the writ petition only with a request to approach the respondents by way of detailed representation supported with all relevant documents and circulars in respect of his claim and with a further request that respondent may consider the same on its own merits in accordance with law.
